

New Phases and Dates:



coronavirus.ohio.gov/vaccine

Phase 1E - MARCH 19, 2021

Ohioans with cancer, chronic kidney disease, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, heart disease, and obesity.

Phase 2C - MARCH 19, 2021

Ohioans ages 40+

Phase 2D- MARCH 29, 2021

Ohioans ages 16+

FRIDAY (3/19) Vaccine Distribution Advances to Phase 1E and 2C

In response to significant increase in the amount of vaccine coming into Ohio, Governor DeWine recently outlined the individuals who are included in Phase 1E and Phase 2C of Ohio's vaccination plan, which will go into effect on Friday, March 19.

Vaccine availability will be expanded to all Ohioans over the age of 16 (Phase 2D) on Monday, March 29th.
