### **Quadrivalent Flu Vaccines for Purchase from LifeCare Alliance**

LifeCare Alliance has quadrivalent flu vaccines available for purchase! The current stock includes about 70 doses. They are stored in multidose vials, each vial costs \$167 and contains 10 doses (\$16.70 per dose). They can also offer flu clinics at your clinic location if necessary. ### Ohio Familes Can Now Gain Access to Rent and Utilities Assistance Through The Ohio Development Services Agency

Starting November 2, 2020, the state of Ohio, working with local Community Action Agencies, will help eligible Ohioans who are behind on rent, mortgage, and water and/or sewer utility bills catch up on past payments back to April 1, 2020. Ohio households with an annual income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines will be eligible for assistance (up to \$43,440 for a 3 person household, up to \$52,400 for a 4 person household, up to \$61,360 for a 5 person household).


