Important News:

The Health Resources and Services Administration released the HRSA 2019-2020 Health Equity Report: Special Feature on Housing and Health Inequalities.

Highlights include:

A special feature on housing and health inequalities in the United States shows the impact of housing status and housing conditions, a key social determinant, on population health and health equity.

Life expectancy for all Americans increased from 68.2 years in 1950 to 78.6 years in 2017, yet for American Indians/Alaska Natives and non-Hispanic Blacks life expectancy was 74.3 and 76.0 years respectively.

Infant mortality rates in the U.S. decreased overall from 6.9 per 1000 live births in 2000 to 5.8 in 2017, yet Black infants are still at more than twice the risk of mortality as White infants.

Children living in subsidized housing units are 4 times more likely to be in fair/poor health than those living in owner-occupied homes (4.4 percent vs. 1.1 percent).

Fauci Says First U.S. COVID-19 Vaccines Could Ship Late December or Early January

Check out this article (click here) discussing the latest information about COVID-vaccine roll-out. If all goes well, the first doses of a safe and effective coronavirus vaccine will likely become available to some high-risk Americans in late December or early January, according to Dr. Anthony Fauci, the top U.S. infectious diseases expert. Moderna and Pfizer started the final stage of clinical testing in late July for a vaccine, with tens of thousands of people taking part in each trial. Pfizer, which was expected to announce interim data in October, is now unlikely to release data before November.
